The following report from Rob was read into the minutes by John McMaster: 2019 BCAWA Club Crush, Dineen Riesling.

An update on the vineyard.

It was a cold winter with a higher than average snow pack, the vineyard did not suffer significantly from the cold temperatures.

The timing of the arrival of spring at Dineen this year was closer to what would be considered normal, and when spring arrived it brought immediate warm temperatures, with the increased snow they had received over winter the combination resulted in an abundance of water in the ground this spring, very good growing conditions so far.

My Order Form is out, I have had a few inquiries, a couple of orders have come in, I will be reaching out before the end of June to get orders confirmed. If you are considering ordering the Dineen Riesling please reach out to me asap so I can gauge the demand and assess people's crushing / destemming needs.

Some concerns have been brought up regarding crushing / destemming, I am willing to work with groups who require crushing / destemming, please reach out to me to discuss further, do not let this be a deterrent to making some club crush Riesling.

The proposal is two parts:

Part 1)

Kamloops is encouraged to send 1 -2 people to Chilliwack for their competition in June , 2019 to see how a competition is run using the computer system.

Part 2)

With Kamloops taking the lead in the competition, a team of Judges in the Lower Mainland would judge a select number of Varieties/Classes (about 80% of the entries) and then 8 judges would take the judged wines and remaining wines to Kamloops where the balance of the wines would be judged, and the results entered into the computer system.

The varieties to be judged in the Lower Mainland and the number of Judges to Kamloops will be determined at the time of the competition but the intent is to ensure a success for Kamloops.
