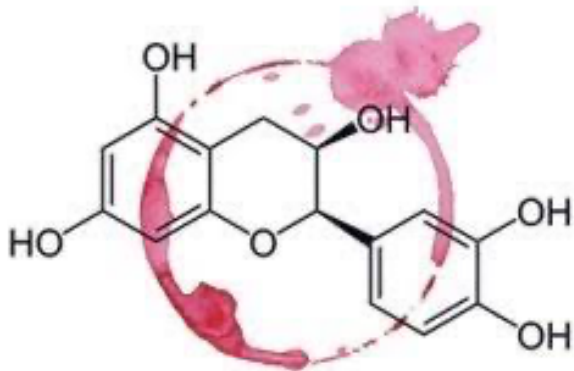


# Wine Phenolics and Tannins Workshop
